Rancho Palos Verdes was incorporated on September 7, 1973. The name reflects its colorful background. In 1784, Juan Jose Domingues asked for and received from the government of Alto California a large piece of land which today is the South Bay Area including the Peninsula. As the years passed Jose Dolores Sepulveda and his family settled here and gained a claim to a section of the Domingues estates. This property was granted by the governor in the 1820's and was to become known as Rancho Palos Verdes. Some 37,000 people are living in the area presently. The city covers 12.3 square miles and boasts approximately 12.5 miles of unspoiled coastline. On the right is an aerial picture of the beautiful Miraleste campus and its surroundings, located in Rancho Palos Verdes.

These three things are joined together in an association called the PTSA: Parent, Teacher, Student Association.

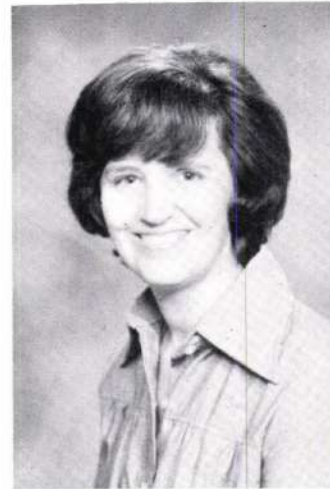
The PTSA's main goal is not, as some think, to raise money. Their main goal is communication, communication among the three facets of a school.

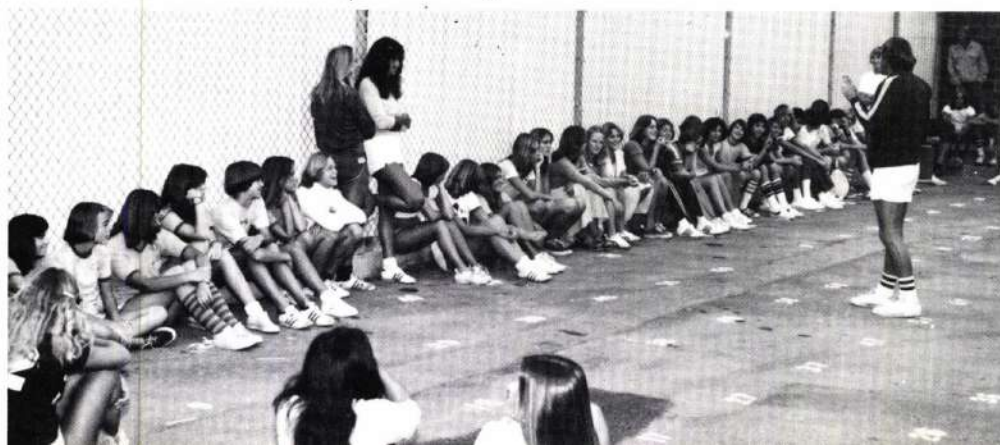
The P.E. department has tried to put their courses together so that the student would get a little of everything.

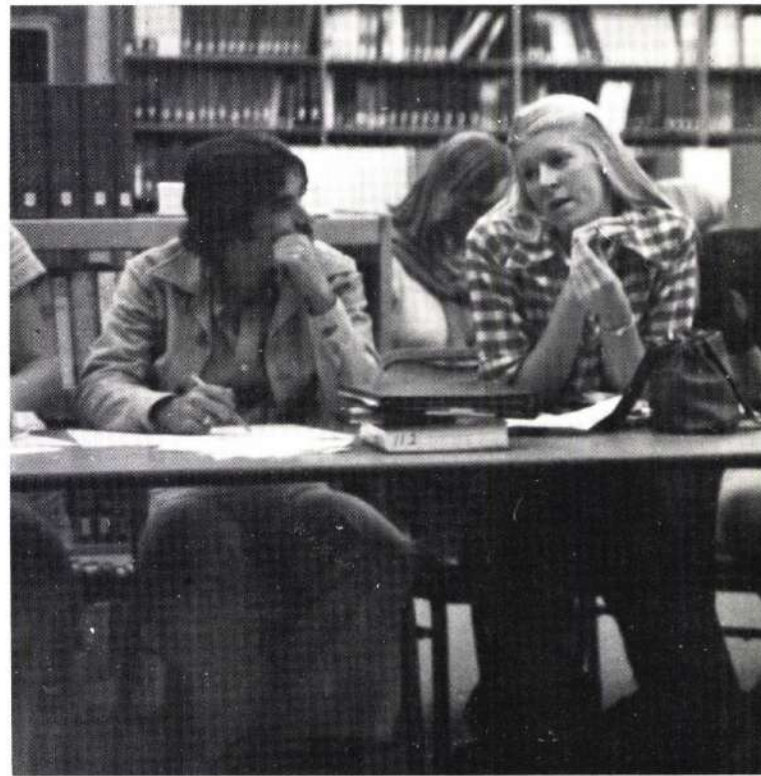
Student Council meetings were held at least every other week and often every week.

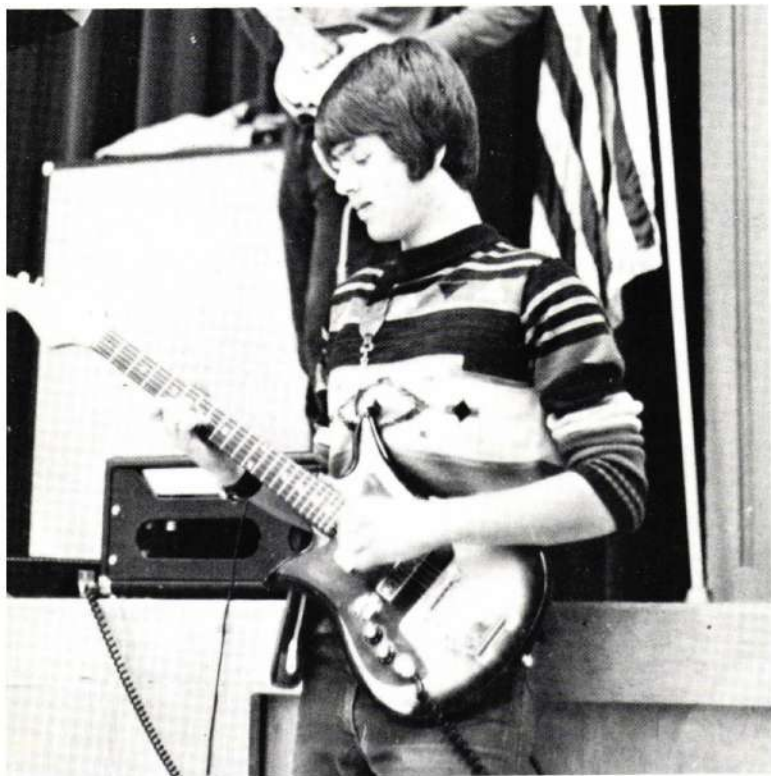

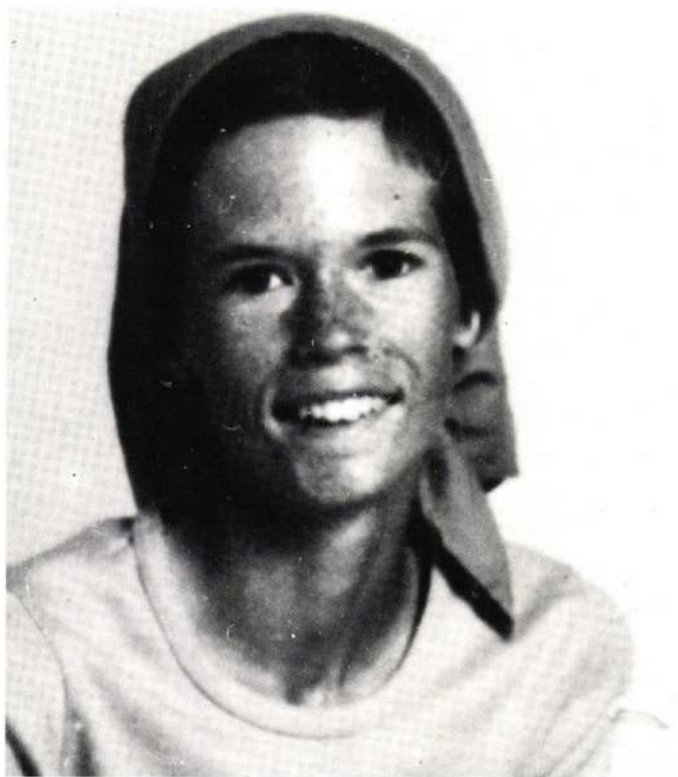


JANET MORRIS (1959-1977)

The move from the 2-A to the 3-A league made the 1976-77 Basketball season tough for the Marauders.

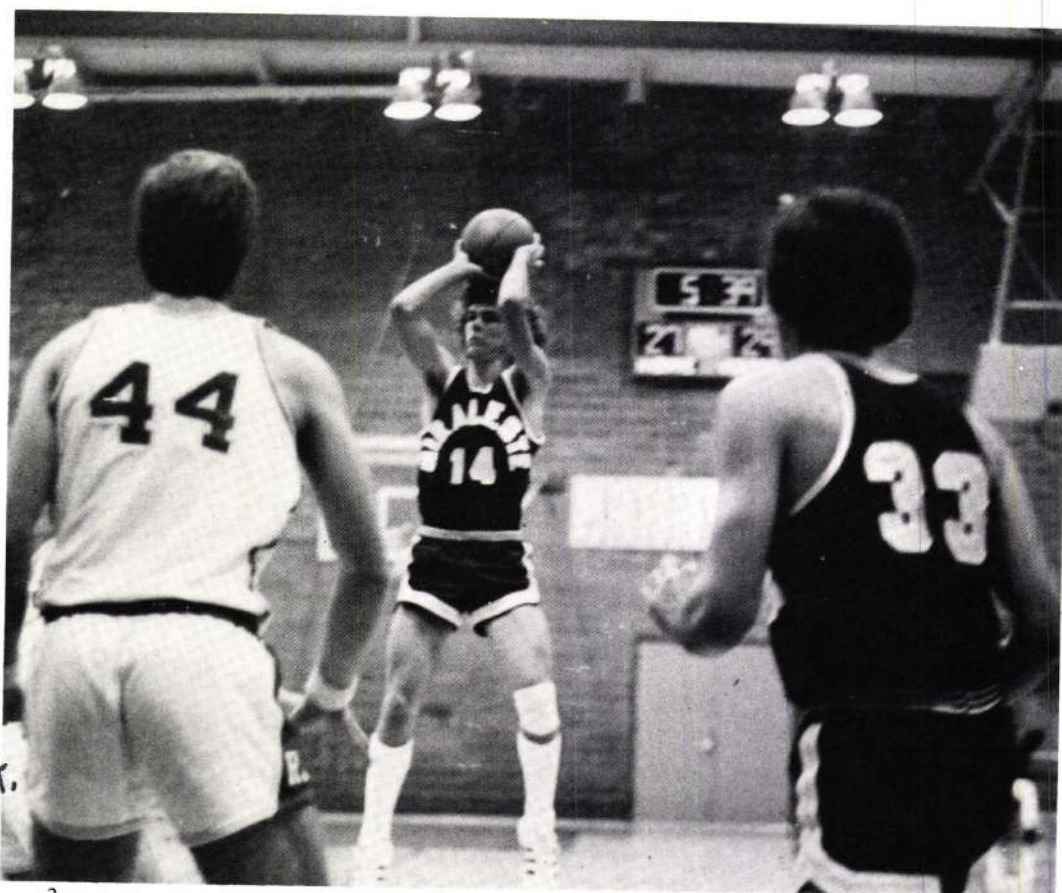

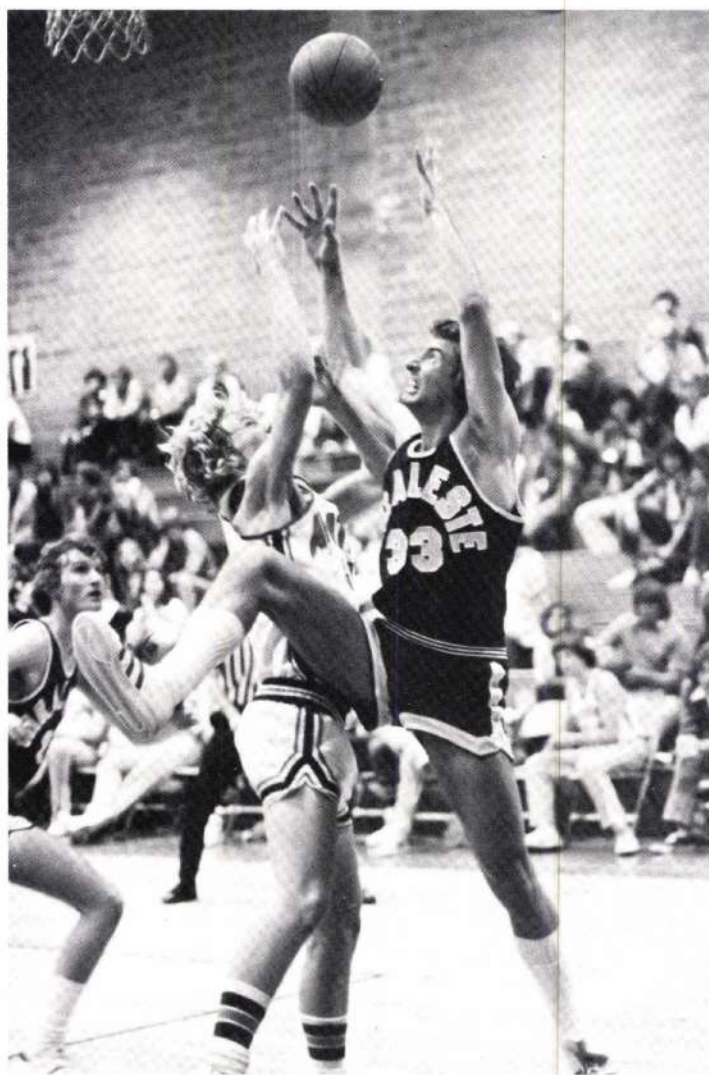

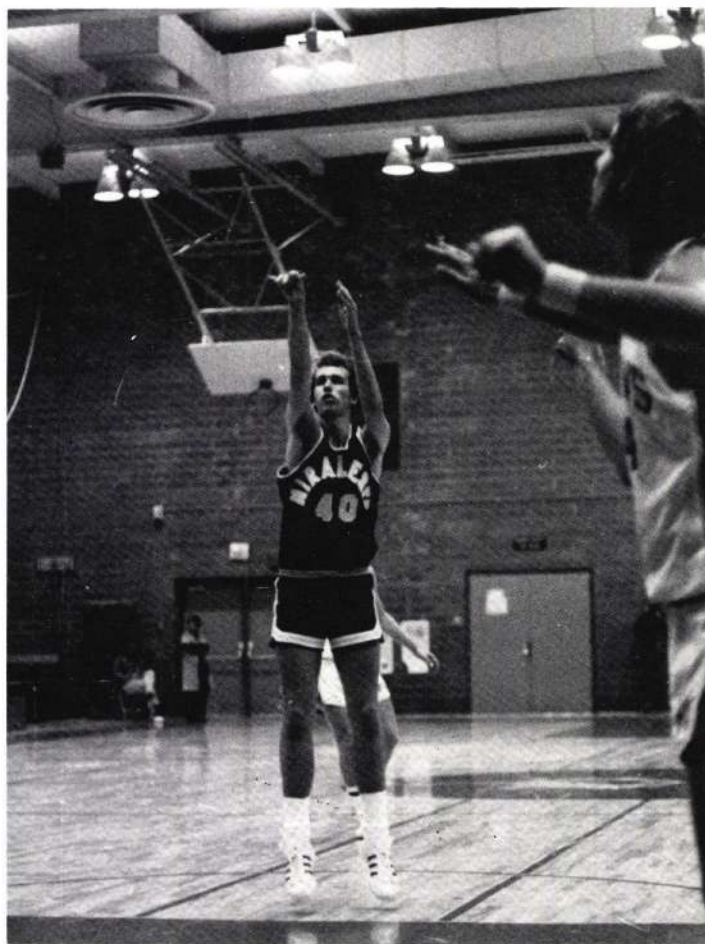

The Junior Varsity team with guidance from Coach John Nursall, a new member of the coaching staff, held their own in the tough Ocean League.

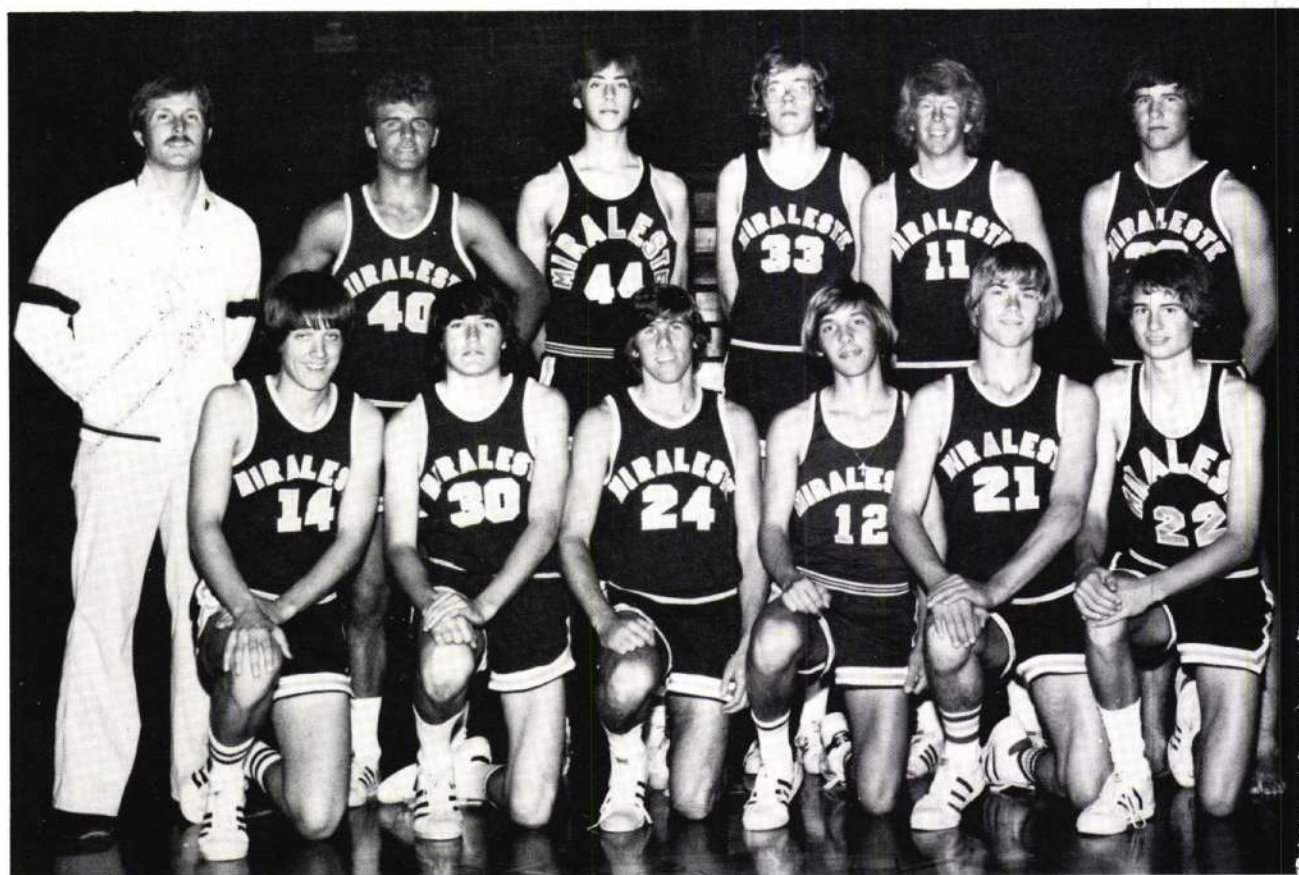

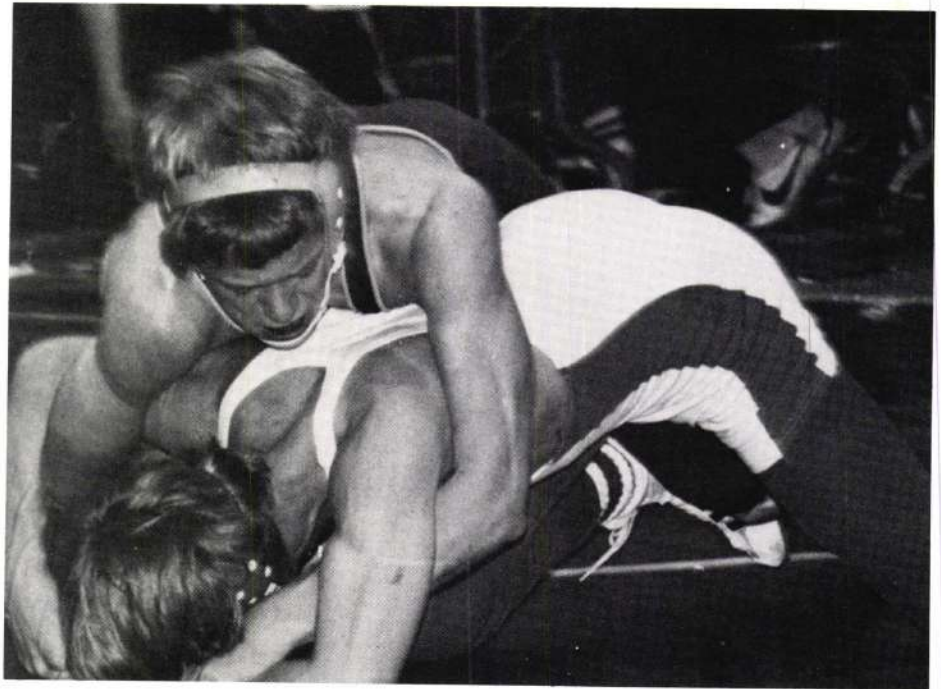

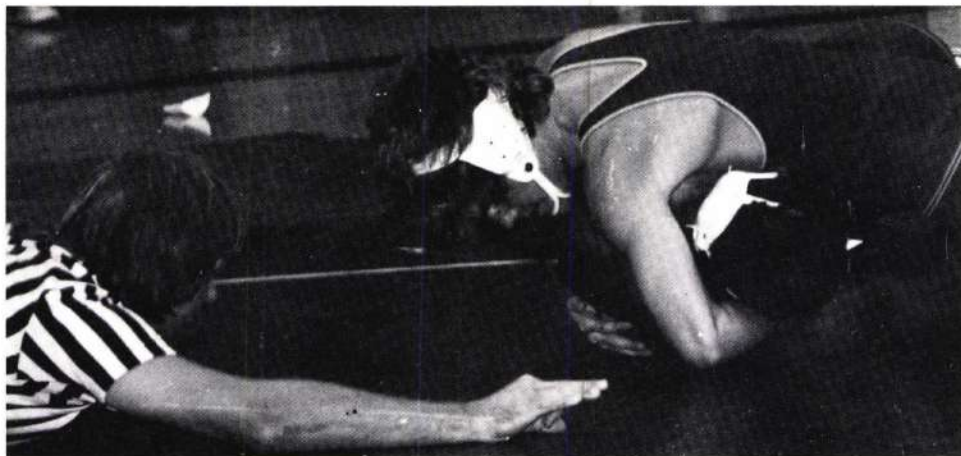

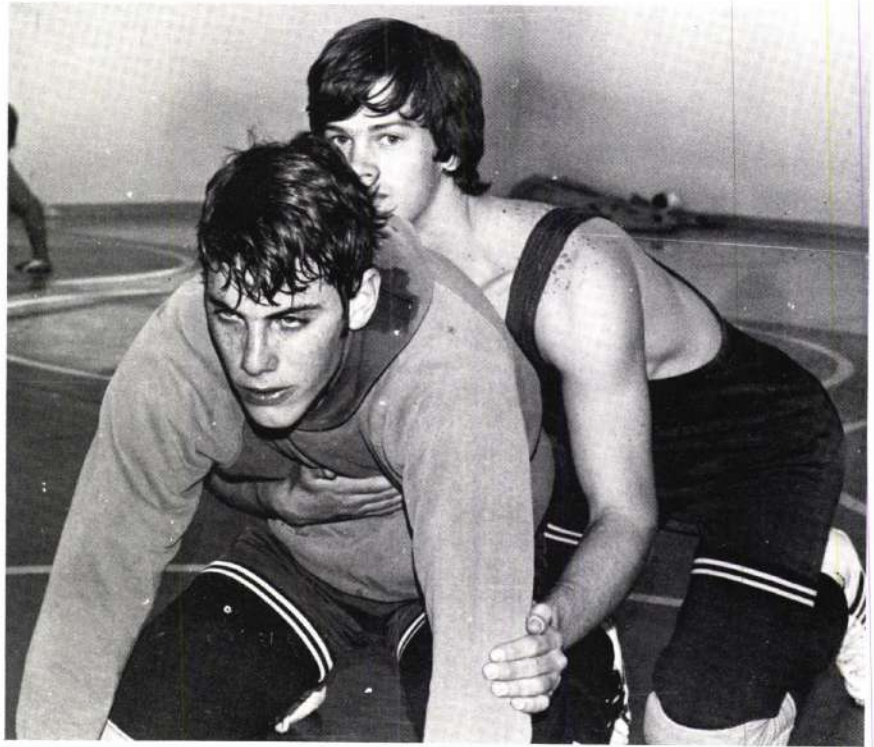
